Fully escorted day tour traveling in a luxury coach, Cheese tasting Bruny Island Cheese, wine tasting of Bruny Island Wine, Lunch at Adventure Bay

Departing from Hobart we travel south into the Huan Valley via Kingston which is also the home base for the Australian Antarctic, to Kettering, a quiet town on the shores of the D'Entrecasteaux Channel. This is the departure point for the 20 minute ferry trip to Bruny Island. The island is 50km long and is divided in the middle into North & South by a narrow strip of land called the Neck.



- **By far the most photographed place on Bruny Island** is Truganini Lookout at the Neck. The neck is a narrow isthmus of sand that joins North and South Bruny Islands. In the middle of the Neck, a dune rises high above the beach. You can take the staircase to the top for incredible views from the top lookout along the coast and looking towards tasman island and port arthur. From here see the optical illusion that make the sea level appear higher on one side than the other. The lookout dedicated to Truganini, a woman who is believed to have been the last full-blooded Tasmanian indigenous person and who was born on Bruny.
- Taste some of the local produce at Bruny Island Cheese which started as a simple dairy but has grown into a fabulous destination. They make artisan cheese and brew excellent beer. The best way to enjoy their cheese is with fresh bread from their wood-fired oven.
- **Explore some of North Bruny.** The main settlement is on the chanale side of the island with views back to the main land. The main commercial settlement is Alonnoh and at Lunawanna the sealed road turns to a dirt one.
- **Adventure Bay** on the ocean front has a long beach and houses looking out over the bay and feels more like a holiday destination.
- **Bruny Island Chocolate** on South Bruny on the road to Adventure Bay. Their small shop has a great selection of handmade chocolates and fudge.
- **Bruny Island Premium Wines** is Australia's southernmost vineyard. We will do an in house wine tasting as we wait to catch the ferry back to the Tasmanian main land.
